To avoid dye migration even on the bright colours, try an anti-migration layer or to keep a softer hand feel; try low cure inks additives and poly blockers. Balance is essential for curing our Electric fabric, too high and the polyester fibres can burn, too low and the print won't cure on the cotton fibres. Monitor the temperature throughout the day as the temperature can creep up! Heat press platens can leave a shine on the fabric, usually removed when washing, but protect fabric by using Teflon/Silicone sheets and padded print pillows. Our Electric tightly knitted surface ensures smooth transfer prints. Make your design pop by experimenting with full colour, glitter, flock, foil and rhinestones for a unique look. Ensure you use a stabilizer on the inside of the garment, behind your embroidery and make sure your needle is smooth and sharp to avoid snagging! Consider your artwork, as a large amount of embroidery could cause some puckering around the design and the gentle drape of these styles.
